INFORMATION FOR SCHOOL NURSES AND SCHOOL PRINCIPALS

The AFDA's Foundation for Children was founded to help provide medical assistance to families who have no insurance, cannot qualify for other institutional aid or potentially for children whose parents simply cannot afford a large medical bill. This is considered on a case by case basis.

All requests for aid must be accompanied with the application form, as much information as possible regarding the medical condition and what is requested in the way of help and who the funds must be made out to. Funds are only given to the provider of the medical assistance or company providing the product or service.

Applications are only taken starting in early August when school starts and ending May 30 or the end of the school year.

Any request over \$250 must go to the Foundation's Board for consideration. Usually they meet each month on the second Thursday of the month.

Emergency medications situations on a one time basis are usually the only time medications might be funded.

The foundation will often ask the parent for a token payment to give some ownership in their child's medical benefit.

Usually payments have a short turn around time.
